The good news is we have a President that understands the principles of business and economic stability so jobs are back!

The good news is that we have a President who understands the dangers and damages of multiculturalism to E Pluribus Unum so discussions of American Exceptionalism are back!

At Stake over next two years:

So just as money should follow children to a school their parents want,

We could allow Retirement funds to be directed to an IRA if the worker wants.

Freedom and Ownership is key to breaking a cycle of poverty.

And to getting buy-in instead of multiculturalism from the folks that today have no stake in America's future.

The opportunity to Build Wealth is one of the most amazing benefits of our free society...

So we need to remove <u>all</u> barriers that force workers to send their potential wealth building funds to the IRS.
